1 AN ACT Relating to the retirement age for state guard members; 2 amending RCW 38.16.015; and declaring an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 38.16.015 and 2012 c 12 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

(1) The period of enlistment in the Washington state guard shall
be set by regulation by the adjutant general <u>or the adjutant</u>
<u>general's designee</u>. ((However, no original enlistment may be
<u>consummated unless the term thereof can be completed before the</u>
applicant attains the age of sixty-four.))

Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section and RCW 11 (2) adjutant general, or the adjutant general's 12 38.12.180(2), the 13 designee, may extend the service age upon request by an active member 14 of the Washington state quard if the adjutant general, or the adjutant general's designee, determines the member's extension would 15 16 be in the best interest of the Washington state guard. Extensions 17 under this subsection have a ((one-year)) two-year duration and may be renewed ((until the member attains the age of sixty-eight)) beyond 18 19 the age of sixty-four, subject to the discretion of the adjutant general or the adjutant general's designee, if: 20

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate 6 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of 7 the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes 8 effect immediately.
